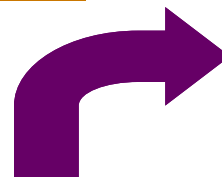

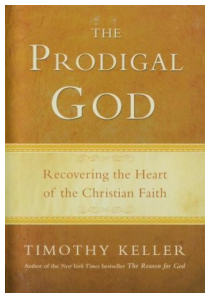

‘Prodigal God’ is PT’s summer book study

In the book review, Newsweek magazine called renowned minister Timothy Keller “a C. S. Kaboom! (Pentecost Sunday, June 12)

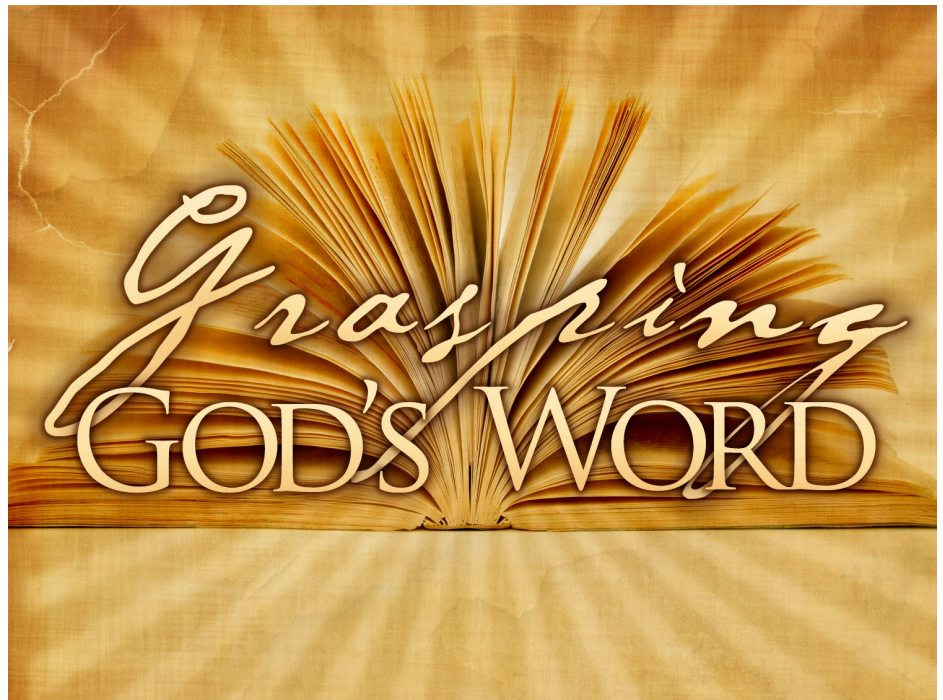

Thrivent Builds – An update and an appeal



Jessica with her nine-year-old son are excited about their new Habitat home. She looks forward to living in a community with other Habitat homeowners, where all the kids can play together, they can get a dog and plant flowers.

Great progress has been made on the Thrivent Builds and Loveland Habitat for Humanity home for Jessica and nine-year-old son! They currently have a roof, exterior siding, roughed in electrical and plumbing; and, by the time you read this, insulated and sheetrocked interior walls. There has been a wonderful outpouring of volunteers from the Lutheran community. The requirement for Lutheran volunteers on this home is 50 percent, and, we are currently at over 90 percent!

With construction moving along so quickly, the only remaining obstacle for Jessica to move in is the funding of the house – our Lutheran community is required to provide 10 percent of the money to build the home (with Thrivent providing 55 percent and Habitat 35 percent). Through gifts in kind (like the plumbing work provided by Ed Bach) we have satisfied about half of that need. We are now conducting a donation appeal for Jessica's home.

Jessica will be at Redeemer's Sunday Adult Education guest on Sunday, July 31

with Gwen Stephenson from Habitat. She will share her story and other facets of Habitat for Humanity and Thrivent Builds.

At our services that day, an offering envelope will be provided in the bulletin. Please make your tax deductible donation check out to Redeemer Lutheran, with a notation in the memo section for "Thrivent Builds." Put the envelope in the offering basket that Sunday, or during the first couple of weeks of August.

An additional fundraiser is currently being planned – a softball tournament that will be held on Sunday afternoon, August 28 at the Barnes fields in Loveland. Details will follow next month.

Listening: One way to show God's love

Communication involves much more than words. Only 7 percent of our communication involves spoken words. About 38 percent is conveyed by body language including gestures and facial expressions and 55 percent by the tone of our voice.

Listening is the most profound way you demonstrate to others you love them. It's impossible to overemphasize the immense need we have to be really listened to, taken seriously and

understood. Let our daily prayers include asking God to teach us to listen to others with our full attention and to *really hear* what people are saying with their whole body, not just their words.

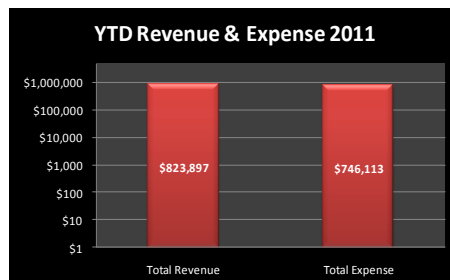
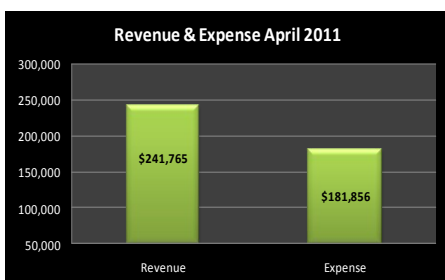
